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GSB ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission requirements are designed to select those who are prepared by experience and prior education to derive the greatest benefit from this advanced bank management program.

Qualifying criteria:

- Officers of FDIC-insured banks or savings institutions with five years of banking experience, as well as a four-year college degree or four additional years of financial services experience.
- State and federal financial institution regulatory officials and directors of banks or savings institutions with educational background and experience comparable to that required of bank officers.
- Non-officer bank or savings institution employees who are performing officer-level functions will be considered if
 their applications are accompanied by letters of recommendation from their chief executive officers describing
 current duties and responsibilities.
- Professionals from firms providing services to banks and savings institutions who have educational and experience
 backgrounds comparable to that required of bank officers will be considered for admission on a case by case basis
 and will be dependent on available space.
