INDIANAPOLIS (Nov. 12, 2024) – Danielle Conner, senior vice president of risk management at Owen County State Bank, Spencer, has been honored with the 2024 Indiana Bankers Association Woman of the Year award, sponsored by Krieg DeVault LLP. She was presented with the award on Wednesday, Nov. 6, during the IBA Banking on Women conference.
