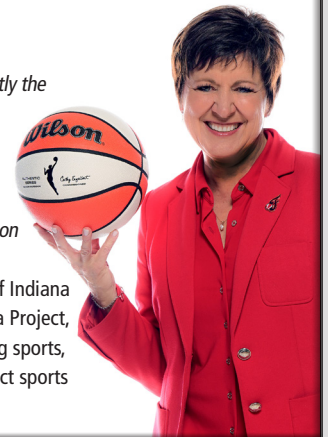

Across all programming, 82% of our girls identify as girls of color, and 62% live in households earning \$30K a year or less.

The combination of long-lasting mentoring relationships, a pro-girl environment, and research-based programming equips girls to navigate gender, economic, and social barriers.
