The Sagamore of the Wabash is given to exemplary Hoosiers in recognition of distinguished statewide service.

Kleer is chairman, president and CEO of First Bank Richmond. His community involvement includes service on the boards of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Wayne County, Reid Health Foundation, Richmond Symphony Orchestra and Wayne County Foundation.

"Garry has done a wonderful job leading the IBA as the 2022 chairman," said Amber R. Van Til, president and CEO of the IBA. "I've come to learn in my travels with Garry and my time spent in his institution that he's wellloved by his employees. I think one of the markers of a true leader – a servant leader, which I know Garry to be – is how the employees view him and receive him."

"Garry is good at organizing people and bringing ideas together. He's very approachable. In 2020, he was awarded the Indiana University Bicentennial Medal for distinguished service, and he currently is a member of the Large Community Bank Council of the Independent Community Bankers of America.
