**Howrey Named Leader
in Banking Excellence**



INDIANAPOLIS (Sept. 14, 2026) – **Matthew W. Howrey**, president and CEO of **North Salem State Bank**, was honored by the Indiana Bankers Association with the IBA Leaders in Banking Excellence award, presented on Sept. 14 during a ceremony as part of the IBA’s Annual Convention at the French Lick Springs Resort. This award celebrates exceptional leaders who have positively impacted Indiana banks and communities. Four other members of the Indiana banking community were also inducted into the class of 2026 leaders.

Matt Howrey has served as president and CEO of The North Salem State Bank since 2010. Prior to joining the bank in 2008 as chief financial officer, he served as a bank examiner for the Indiana Department of Financial Institutions. During his tenure, the bank has grown from \$125 million in assets to nearly \$800 million and is routinely one of the highest performing community banks. Howrey served as chairman of the Indiana Bankers Association in 2025 and played a vital role in the development of the IBA’s Financial Services Academy. He also serves numerous community and economic development organizations, and actively volunteers as a coach and fundraiser for youth sports. Howrey was named a Distinguished Hoosier by Gov. Mike Braun in 2025 and was named a Rising Star in Banking in 2013 by Northwestern Financial. He earned bachelor’s and MBA degrees from Indiana University.
