He is a past president of both the Parks Foundation of Hendricks County and the Greencastle-Putnam County Economic Development Center.

"Matt has been described by his colleagues as a leader who cares less for making a legacy for his own name than he does for making his community, his industry and our Association better," said Amber R. Van Til, president and CEO of the IBA. "His passion for building the next generation of the workforce and offering young Hoosiers not just a job but a career they can be proud of, will make a lasting impact for generations to come and make him a worthy recipient of this honor."

Howrey earned a bachelor's degree and an MBA from Indiana University, and was named a Rising Star in Banking in 2013 by Northwestern Financial (now BankBeat) magazine.
